

## **Mihály Jambrik**

Born in 1956 in Gádoros (Békés County);

Graduated in 1980 from Karl Marx University of Economics;

Earned an MBA in 1998 at a course run jointly by the American Purdue University and the French College for Trade of Rouen;

Spent 22 years of his professional career at various companies in the telecom sector, holding a raft of managerial positions in the last 12 years;

Started his career as an economist at Magyar Posta, working primarily on telecom tariff and cost modeling. Later, he worked as an economic analyst at the General Directorate of Magyar Posta. He was involved in the separation of the official and business functions of the Hungarian Post and its division into three companies;

From the establishment of MATÁV, he held various managerial positions at the company for 11 years, working as its general director responsible for economics between 1994 and 2000. He was involved in the preparation of MATÁV's privatisation and its flotation in the stock exchange and he was in charge of selling assets to LTOs. As general director responsible for economic affairs, he was in charge of pricing at MATÁV as well as the economic and controlling fields.

In 2001 he was deputy general manager responsible for economic affairs at Vivendi Telecom Hungary.

In June 2002, he was appointed as deputy secretary of state responsible for economic affairs in the Ministry of Informatics and Communications.

As of April 2003, he serves as Administrative State Secretary in the Ministry of Informatics and Communications.
