Vladan Zivulovic was born in 1956 in Belgrade where he has graduated at the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law. He has entered legal profession in 1982 and has taken jurisprudence exam in 1984.

During his successful carrier as a lawyer he was also Director of the Institute for Geopolitical Studies (1996-1998). At that time the Institute has printed many titles such as:

"Kosovo and Metohija - challenges and answers"	published in 1997, Belgrade
"Geopolitical Reality of Serbs"	published in 1997, Belgrade
"Great Albania-Concepts and Possible Consequences"	published in 1998, Belgrade
"Geopolitics of Chaos"	published in 1998, Belgrade

From 1998 until 2000 Vladan Zivulovic was Chairman of the Council for Democratic Changes. This NGO united Serbian diaspora and democratic forces in the country. Through the period of 3 years Council for Democratic Changes has had many activities against Milosevic regime, such as: the organization of the Conference in Sent Andrea, Hungary, where all the opposition parties against Milosevic met for the first time. This NGO at 1999 published the Handbook for Democratic Government in Serbia. Prominent Serbian experts from most important fields proposed in this handbook how to solve short-term and long-term political and economic problems after the fall of Milosevic.

Since 2001 Mr Zivulovic is the President of the Atlantic Council of Serbia and Montenegro (ACSM). ACSM is a member of the Atlantic Treaty Association. Through many activities this NGO is promoting Euro-Atlantic values and Euro-Atlantic integrations.

As a lawyer Mr Zivulovic is legal adviser of his Royal Highness Prince Aleksandar II Karadjordjevic. His specialization is corporate law.
